

Draft Resolution Proposal: Constitutional Protection Act

Introduction

Begun and held at the City of Washington, the ___ day of _____, two thousand and ___, a Joint Resolution:

To protect our Constitution and safeguard the liberties of our loyal and patriotic citizenry through the repeal of Public Law 107-40.

Whereas, war, when referred to in our Constitution, is limited in use to describing armed struggle between nations,

Whereas the perpetrators of the attacks of September 11, 2001 represent no nation and no nation claims them nor can rightly be held accountable as a nation for their crimes,

Whereas Public Law 107-40 granted the office of the President specific statutory authorization within the meaning of section 5(b) of the War Powers Resolution,

Whereas that authorization has since been exploited and abused as the legislative embodiment of the so-called "Global War on Terror",

Whereas the acts of this administration under cover of pursuing the so-called "Global War on Terror" have failed to apprehend the organizers of the attacks of September 11, 2001, and have squandered the international good will enjoyed by the United States in the wake of those attacks and have increasingly undone safeguards on the liberties of our loyal and patriotic citizenry, and

Whereas the above is both accurate and true: Now, therefor be it

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of American in Congress assembled,

Section 1 - Short Title

This joint resolution may be cited as the 'Constitutional Protection Act'.

Section 2 - Constitutional Protection Act

(a) IN GENERAL - The passage of Public Law 107-40 is found to be unconstitutional on its face and reflective of a dangerous disregard of policies and laws designed to protect not only the lives but also the liberties and inalienable rights of loyal and patriotic citizens, and so is hereby immediately repealed.

(b) LIABILITIES CREATED - The fallacious reasoning of which Public Law 107-40 was born is repudiated and all persons shall be held fully liable for any wrongs, civil and criminal, which they have committed under cover of Public Law 107-40 or at anytime since its passage.
